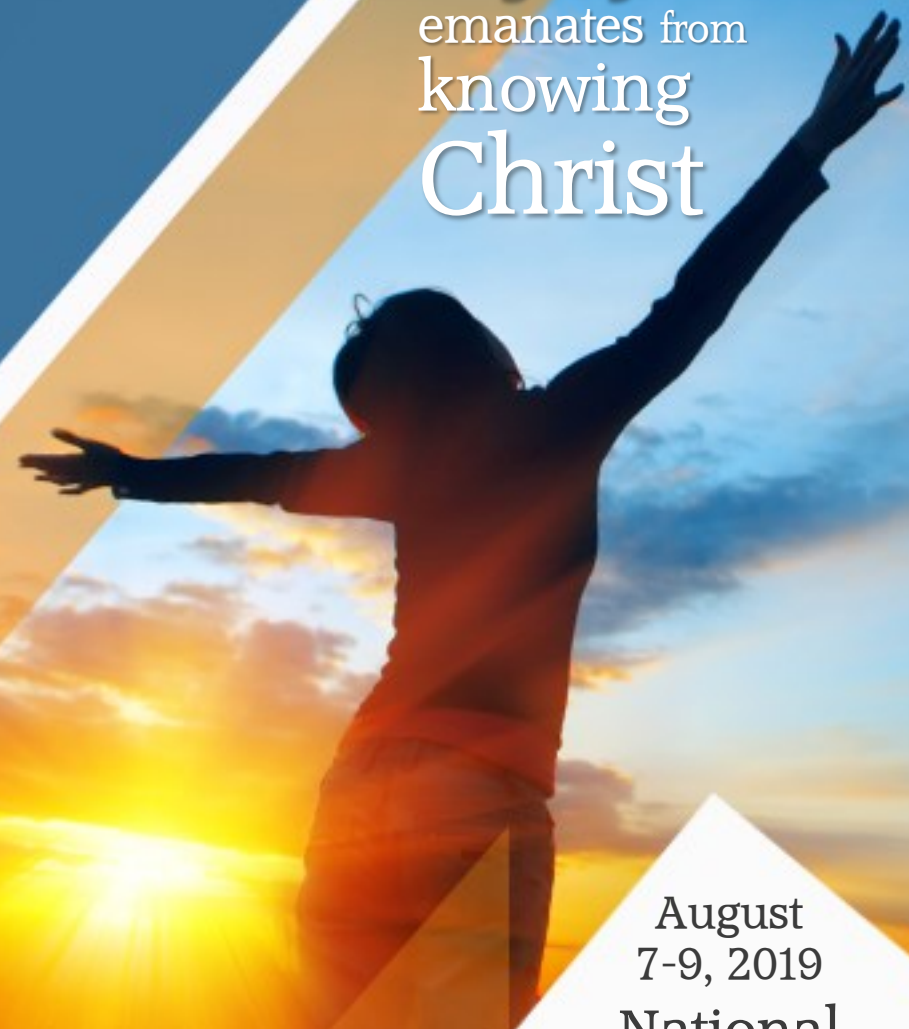

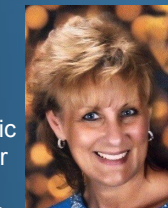


Chief of Police Frank L. Fowler
