We continue to do this program in many places in Uganda where we have the machines and teachers to educate the girls in this trade. One of our orphan girls that was so thankful was Olivia. Her mom and dad were accused of being witch doctors which was untrue and they were taken and executed by the towns people in front of her and her brother. We were able to set her up with a brand new sewing machine, material and training to help to enable her to start a business to earn income. This was such a beautiful thing for her life and we are so thankful to God for His continual guidance in everything we are able to do to glorify His name!

We were so blessed to bring with us many beautiful handmade dresses and shorts that were made by both Vicky Loven and East Middlebury United Methodist Church.
